

EDIBLE CAMPFIRE

Practice building a campfire without burning your fingers! Gather up all the items to build and eat a pretend campfire.

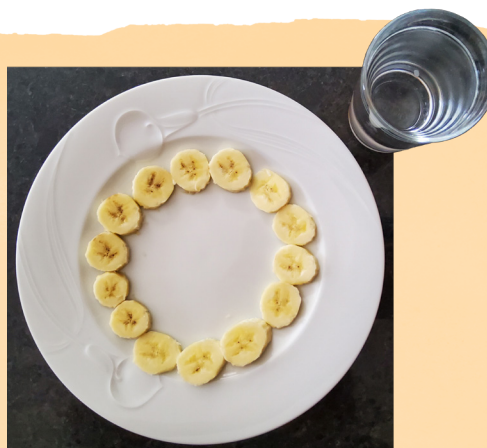
Materials

- Plate (*camp site*)
- Cup with water (*to put out your fire*)
- Toothpick (*match*)
- Mini marshmallows, nuts or banana slices (*fire ring*)
- Shredded coconut or cheese (*tinder**)
- Pretzel sticks or small matchstick slices of apple or pear (*kindling**)
- Larger matchstick slices of apple or pear (*logs*)
- Sliced strawberries or red apple skin (*fire*)

Steps

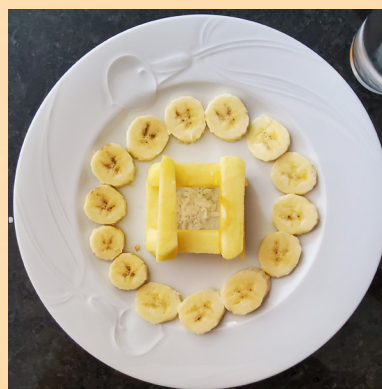
1. Place your campsite on a flat surface. Make sure to have your water nearby.

Use your mini-marshmallows, nuts or banana slices to make your campfire ring. The fire should always stay inside this ring.



2. Build a cabin shape* of logs with your larger matchstick slices of apple or pear.

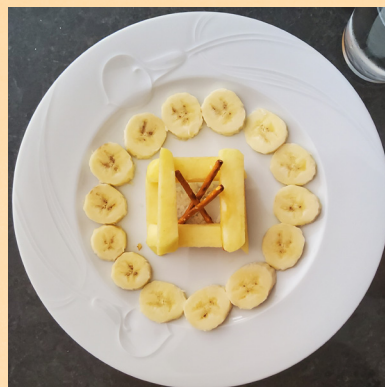
Place some shredded coconut or cheese (*tinder**) inside the log cabin.

Steps *(continued)*

3. Make a tipi of kindling* (pretzels sticks or small matchstick slices of fruit) around the tinder.



4. Light the tinder with the match and add some small flames (sliced strawberries or red apple skin).

Add the rest of your flames and enjoy!



Do not leave your fire unattended and make sure your campsite is clear before leaving. In other words: eat it all!

To put out the fire, pour water over the flames and stir up the fire until it is no longer hot.
