Lane Reductions on Nassau Mills Road

Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site

May 2, 2017, Peterborough, ON – Parks Canada will be removing a tree affected by Emerald Ash Borer on Thursday, May 4th, 2017 at Sawer Creek Lock 25 along the Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site.

In order to complete this work, the section of Nassau Mills Road adjacent to Lock 25 will be intermittently reduced to one lane throughout the day.

Public safety is a top priority for Parks Canada. Given the proximity of the affected tree to the visitor area along the Waterway, it is deemed necessary to remove it.

Parks Canada wishes to thank the public for their patience during this time.

Emerald Ash Borer is a non-native beetle that is responsible for the mortality of ash trees in Ontario and Quebec.
