Swift Rapids, Lock 43 Access Road Closure

Trent-Severn Waterway National Historic Site

Peterborough, Ontario, June 19, 2017 – The Swift Rapids Lock 43 access road, a largely unmaintained extension of Carlyon Road in Severn Township, will be closed for repair on intermittent weekdays between June 20th and August 1st. Work will take place between the hours of 8:30 AM and 7:30 PM. Four existing structural steel and wooden deck bridges along this primarily single-lane road will be repaired.

The Swift Rapids road provides seasonal access to both the lock and hydro facility, as well as providing an access route for trappers and snowmobilers.

This work is a part of significant infrastructure investments that are being made in our national historic sites, national parks and national marine conservation areas.
