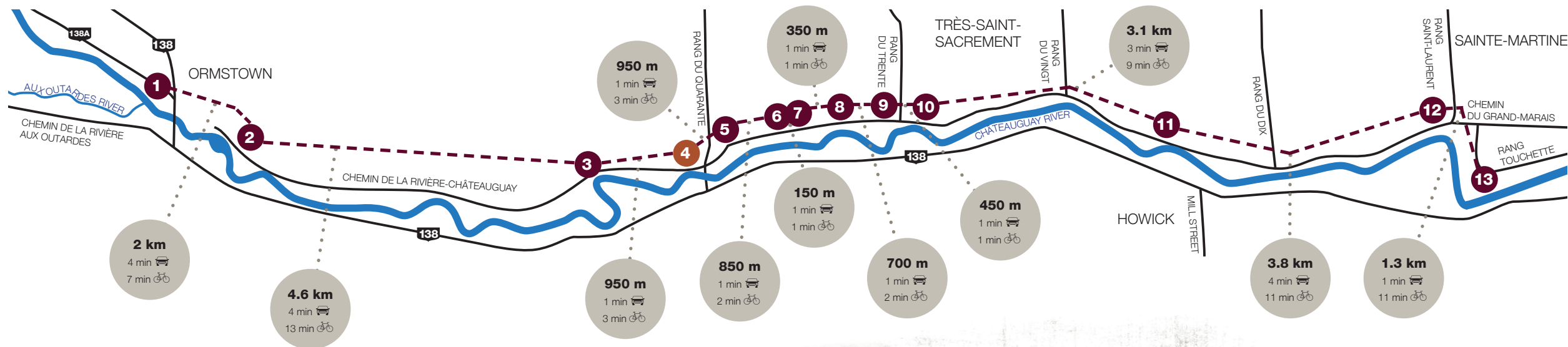

COMMEMORATION
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Use the map (see previous page), nearby roads and addresses, and the geographic coordinates (see table on the right) to locate and explore the 13 historical markers. Once there, you can admire the scenery and read descriptions (available in both English and French). Allow approximately 60 minutes by car or 90 minutes by bike to complete the itinerary from Ormstown to Sainte-Martine. **Please note:** be vigilant towards other road users. Pay particular attention to where you decide to pull over and only stop at the markers when it is safe to do so. Respect the flora, fauna, and neighbourhoods near the markers.
