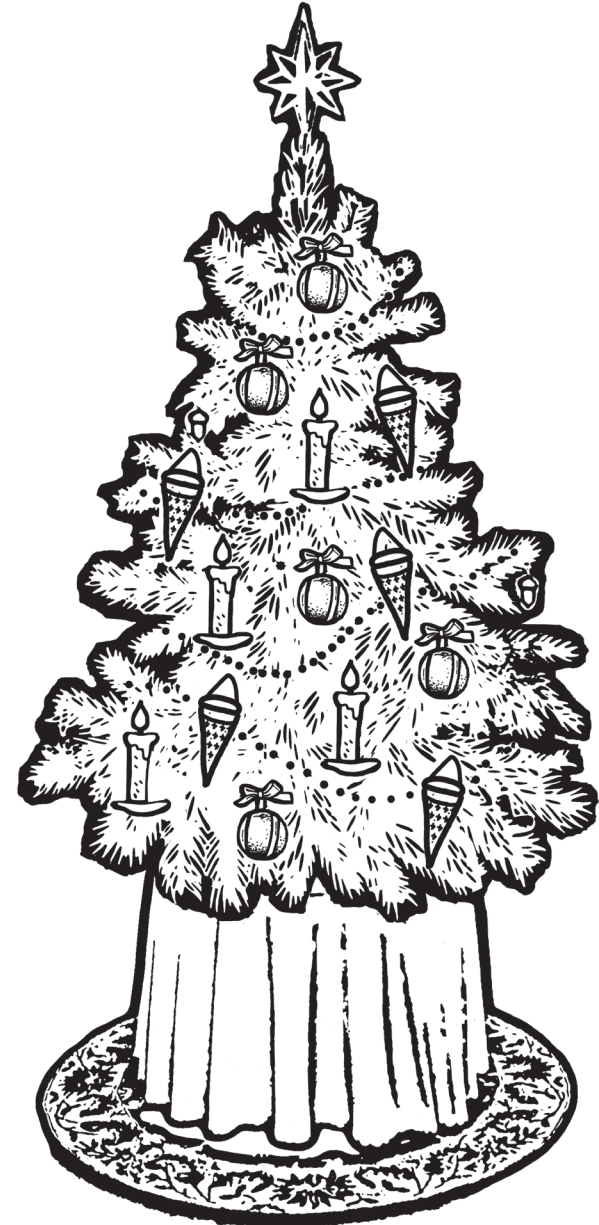


In the years 1860 to 1885, during the Victorian era, people decorated their Christmas tree with objects handmade by family members. Commercially manufactured decorations began to appear among the wealthy around 1870. It was documented that in 1875, the wife of Governor Dufferin (whom Dufferin Terrace in Quebec is named after) embellished her Christmas tree with glass balls.
