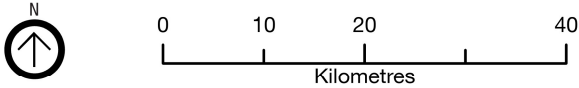


Launching and landing is not permitted in townsites; campgrounds and day-use areas; operation centres; helipads; aggregate pits; highways, roads, utilities and their rights-of-way; third-party leaseholder areas; areas under active closures or restrictions.

Pilots must strive to avoid disturbing medium and large wildlife species. If medium and large wildlife is observed, pilots must fly away from the area immediately. If it is not possible to leave the area, pilots must should maintain a distance of at least 500 metres away from wildlife.

Use discretion when launching or landing in public areas to minimize disturbance.
