

The Lake Connector shuttle is only available to Parks Canada shuttle reservation holders and Roam Reservable Super Pass holders. Seats are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Return shuttle service from either lake back to the Lake Louise Park and Ride is also included with a shuttle

Travel on Roam Public Transit route 8X and on Parks Canada Lake Connector Shuttle with a Reservable Super Pass. The Reservable Super Pass is sold via Roam's online reservation system
