Cell phone coverage is variable throughout the park. Do not rely on it. Let someone know where you are going before you start your adventure.

Keep our forest safe by not moving firewood. There could be invasive pests - like the emerald ash borer - hiding in the wood. Wasagaming campers can purchase firewood at the campground.

- Keep a safe distance from all wildlife. If an • animal notices you by lifting its head, looking at you or listening to you, you are too close and should back away.
- Travelling in groups and making noise will ۰ let wildlife know you are nearby.
- Late summer and early fall is elk and moose • mating season; be especially aware of wildlife along trails at this time.
- **Do not feed wildlife**; they have a greater rate • of survival and are healthier when they feed on natural food.
- Keep your pet on a leash and under physical • control at all times. Dogs can provoke defensive behaviour in bears and other wildlife.
- Read the Bear Aware brochures, available at any park facility.
