

- The red knot is a medium-sized shorebird with long bill that is great for picking out food from the wet sand;
- The red knot is found on all continents except for Antarctica;
- Wapusk National Park's muddy and sandy shores provide the perfect stopover habitat for the red knot birds during their migration - and stopovers are important for the red knot as they have one of the longest migrations of any bird.
