

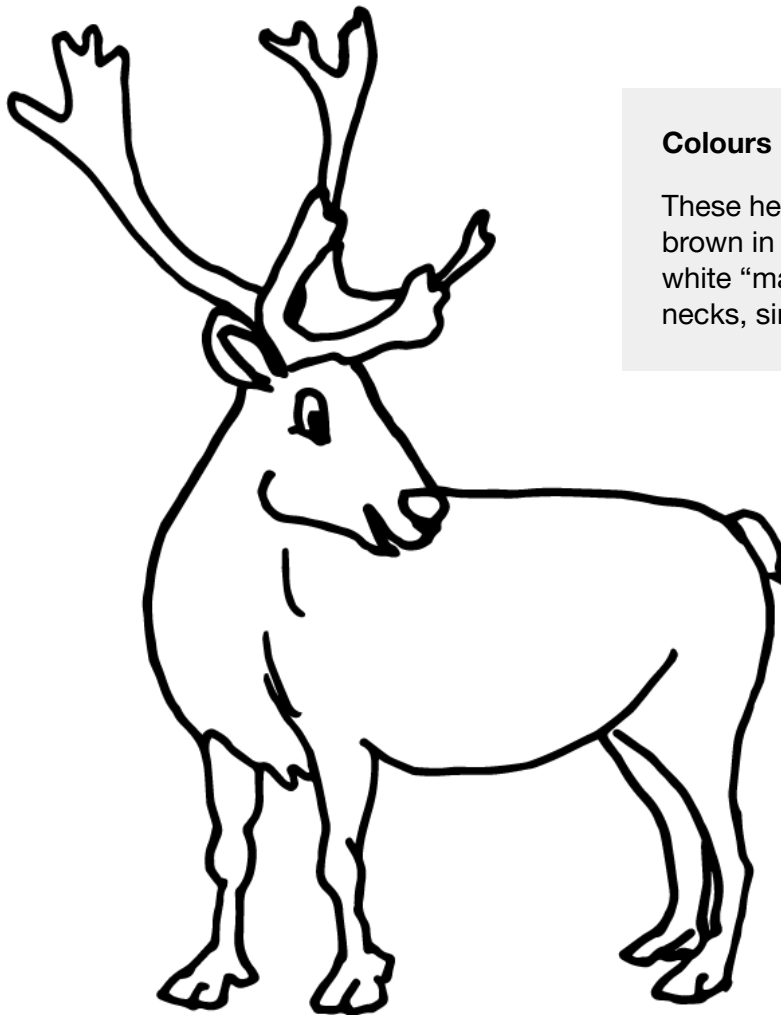

# Eastern Migratory Caribou



### Colours

These herd animals are mostly dark brown in colour, but often have a white “mane” of sorts around their necks, similar to a lion!

### Fun Facts

- Each year, caribou herds use the beach ridges of Wapusk National Park to travel as far as 200 km between their winter and summer ranges;
- Caribou are the same species as reindeer and the only member of the deer family (Cervidae) where both males and females have antlers;
- Northern Indigenous communities have strong ties to the caribou that date back thousands of years. Caribou has a central role in northern Indigenous cultures and diets.
