



# FOOD CACHING REQUEST FORM

## **Requirement:**

Pursuant to subsection 7.1(4) of the *National Parks General Regulations*, any person intending to cache food shall apply for and obtain an authorization from the field unit superintendent and shall comply with all terms and conditions prescribed therein.

Food caches must: 1) be contained in bear proof containers; 2) be labeled properly with name and address of the visitor who will be utilizing the food cache, and; 3) be cached in a location approved by the superintendent.
